Start-ups in Switzerland

Around 5% of Swiss start-ups are based in the Canton of Zug. With the largest concentration of start-ups in Switzerland, the Canton of Zug ranks third in the cantonal comparison of start-up foundations, mainly thanks to Fintech and the Crypto Valley. The survival rate of start-ups is very high by international standards. Specifically, 80% of newly founded enterprises make it their first year, and 50% remain active over the next five years. Companies here benefit from a stable economic climate. Switzerland is continually top ranked within the most innovative countries worldwide. Switzerland's excellent education system and the high density of patents per million inhabitants are significant contributing factors.

Start-ups in the Canton of Zug


